### OVER THE PAST WEEK!!!!

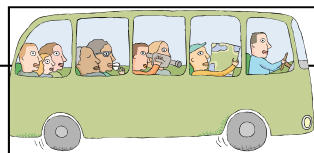

Nursery are visiting Whitehouse Farm on Thursday.



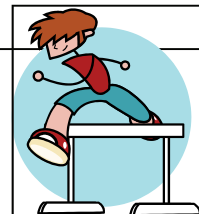
### RECEPTION INDUCTION
